Best known for its **quality fynbos gin**, **Sugarbird** has negotiated access to aged barrels of **potstill brandy** from one of the world's finest, award-winning distilleries – right here in South Africa.

Chenin Blanc and **Colombard grapes**, grown in the **Breedekloof region**, provide the distillate that is carefully aged in small **French Oak barrels**, for 14 years.

Ultimately, once the ageing process has completed, this delicate liquid is **trickle-filtered through honeybush** and other fynbos botanicals by Sugarbird's Artisan Blender, Edmund Paulsen, who says; "*this adds a very subtle character to one of the finest 'Cognacs' around.*" Finally, a little squeeze of fynbos honey gives it a natural smooth nuttiness."

Floral Kingdom is on our doorstep – it is by far the smallest, but richest of the world's six floral kingdoms, in terms of plant and flower diversity. It has given us a wealth of flavour profiles, first used in our gin, where it found harmony between floral and citrus notes, and now, in our potstill brandy."
