Without a doubt, gin has been one of the Mother City's most-loved alcohol options of the year, causing a boom in the industry and inspiring many to become GINuinely interested in this juniper creation.

So if there's a gin-lover in your life and you are looking for the perfect gift for them ahead of the festive season or just for yourself, have no fear, our GINgle bells gift guide is here.

1. Roku Gin - Festive Pack



Gin can often be a pricey gift, but it truly doesn't have to be.

Roku Gin by Suntory is one of the newest gins on the block, making its debut in South Africa this year.

You can grab a festive pack complete with two measuring glasses and a gin for just R299 at all major liquor stores.

This gin has delightful cherry blossom and green tea notes with floral flavours and is best enjoyed with ginger sticks and tonic.

2. Hope on Hopkins - Christmas Collection



Hope on Hopkins Distillery is getting into the Christmas spirit with their latest collection of festive-themed gin.

Perfect for the holiday season, their Frankincense, Gold and Myrrh gins are the perfect gift for your festive GINthusiast.

The gift pack consists of a 200ml bottle of each gin. 'Gold' has a gold-tinged colour as a result of gentle aging and is infused with festive orange peel, cinnamon, nutmeg and almond. A slice of orange is best as a garnish. The 'Frankincense' has smoky nots as resin is its signature botanical with cinnamon, coriander and cumin to complement the flavour. Best garnished with orange zest. Lastly, the 'Myrrh' gin is flavoured with myrrh and paired with cloves, allspice, star anise and nutmeg. Rosemary is the best garnish for this unique gin creation.

In total, the gift pack will cost you R420 and is available in store and at selected liquor stores.

#### 3. Sugarbird Gin Advent Calendar



This one is definitely for the gin connoisseur so make sure you've got someone with a real gin passion in mind.

Sugarbird Gin has collaborated with a number of their gin friends this year to bring us the Gin Advent Calendar.

For a total of 25 days, they have put together a selection of different gins that will treat you to a new flavour and infusion every day.

This option is more on the pricey side, retailing for R699 at Pick n Pay but it is definitely worth every penny.

### 4. New Harbour Distillery Holiday Cocktail Kits



If you're looking to gift yourself or another gin-crazed individual something special this festive season, the cocktail kits from New Harbour Distillery are gin goals.

Try out any of their two remaining options, from the Pink Kit which comes with their sweet Maroela gin, Grapefruit Bitters and Hibiscus & Ginger Simple Syrup, to their Yellow Kit which comes with a Rooibos-infused, Orange Bitters and Burnt Cassia & Fig Simple Syrup. Both kits also come with four Barker and Quintillion's tonics.

This is the perfect gift for the gin-lover who likes to mix things up and try new things. The packs retail for R650, but are currently on sale for R450.

These are available at YuppieChef and online and will cost you roughly R149 so this is a great money-saver option for the festive season.
