NUMBER EIGHT: Sugarbird, Cape Fynbos Gin

This floral gin is distinctively crafted in Cape Town. She exudes notes of Rooibos, honeybush, rose geranium and the may flower, obtained by botanists from the Cape's iconic mountain-Table Mountain. Great in a cocktail of lemon flavoured tonic water and round slices of grapefruit and rosemary.
